The young Clément Magliocco cultivates 1/4 hectare (1) of magnificent organic vines on the heights of Chamason and makes two or three micro-vintages in his garage. This leaves him time to work as an agro-technical collaborator specialized in organic viticulture at the Office de la Viticulture du Canton du Valais. The unusual journey of this endearing winegrower has encouraged us to offer his vintages, in order to encourage and accompany him in a process that must inevitably lead him to "natural" vinifications. The step was taken in 2021 with a very nice and fruity pinot noir.

Patrick Meyer, one of the "veterans" of natural wine, admirably masters his long vinifications without added sulphites. His wines are elegant and digestible, with great purity of taste, underpinned by a beautiful minerality. Remarkable choice of "vins de soif" (tasty blends from the last vintage) as well as "vins de terroir" (Alsatian grape varieties in an expression devoid of their varietal characters) with, as a bonus, superb "voile" and "orange" wines (macerated pinot gris, muscat and gewürztraminer).

For thrill-seekers. Microscopic production, biodynamic, no added sulphites. The former photographer of Chanel admirably works his vines planted with old, even very old chardonnays in the Mâcon and Viré Clessé appellation area. The very type of a "living wine": far from certain flat and non-aromatic Burgundies, these wines are voluminous, complex and salty. Their tension and purity are reminiscent of the great wines of the Jura. The minerality speaks for itself!

Arc et Senans

The former history and geography teacher now devotes all his time to his 4 hectares of organic land. In addition to the Ratapoil cuvée (a blend of Jura grape varieties that have almost disappeared), he produces all the grape varieties of the Jura: chardonnay, pinot noir, poulsard and trousseau. Work in the cellar is reduced to a minimum with little intervention. Native yeasts, of course, no filtration or fining. Sulphur in homeopathic doses. Straight and easy, straightforward wines, which benefit considerably from being a little expected.

Wines of great joviality, in the image of their craftsman who (like his friend Raphaël Monnier) finally gave up teaching to take care of his 5 hectares of vines; five Jura grape varieties planted on varied soils (clay, marl, limestone) give a beautiful range of cuvées, finely elaborated by Jean-Ba and his associate Florian Kleine Snuerink. Their great drinkability does not exclude a real character and a good aptitude for ageing.

LES GRANGEONS DE L'ALBARINE

Luc Bauer

At the bottom of the Albarine valley, in the heart of Bugey, Luc Bauer practises "haute couture" viticulture (organic and biodynamic, of course) on some 3 hectares. He vinifies altesse, mondeuse, gamay and pinot noir in various containers (depending on the cuvées) without any inputs, except a mini dose of sulphites. And, after a long ageing process, bottles a series of beautiful lively wines characterized by their complexity and stability.

On an estate of barely 6 ha, planted with Syrah for the reds, Marsanne, Viognier and Roussanne for the whites, Jean-Pierre Monier (now joined by his sons) has been practising biodynamics since 1996 and produces some very remarkable Saint Joseph, not forgetting some lovely wines in the "Collines rhodaniennes" appellation. The high quality of the harvest allows for a gentle vinification, the very fine juices not suffering at all from a year spent in barrels and giving wines with a powerful, straight and firm body, which age admirably.

Since 2015, the former bookseller and his wife Charlotte have settled near Cahors, in an old abandoned farmhouse. They have planted vines there and make wine, natural of course... Their vines are pampered and the fine juices obtained are vinified, without the addition of sulphites, in the troglodytic cellar in an old quarry. Full of fruit and energy, the cots (or malbec) of L'Ostal Levant are endearing wines with a strong personality. Since 2019, the estate also produces magnificent whites in homeopathic quantities.

By dint of hard work and questioning, Mathias and Camille Marquet show the mastery of the "old" that they are far from being already. Wines with a high emotional content: whites with a full texture and a whole range of reds, some with a very fine Loire finesse (La Plantureuse, for example), others (such as Racigas) more powerful, tannic and betraying their Bergerac terroir. Do not forget the "specialties" (sweet "sous voile" wines). Since 2017 (due to climatic conditions), a range of "vins de négociant" (out of organic grapes purchased from other friendly growers and vinified by Mathias) has been added under the Hors les murs label.

Christophe Bosque combines the activities of "négoce" with those of a winemaker on his 2 hectares of Muscadet vines. Above all, he is a passionate person, free to select, for his trade, the cuvées of already known winemakers or young talents to be discovered. Living soils, cultivation without synthetic molecules, respectful oenology with little or no inputs are absolute imperatives in his quest for pure vibrations and sensations.

Organic farming (certified) and non-interventionist vinification, carried out in a troglodyte cellar in Thoré la Rochette, in stainless steel vats for L'Appel du Large, and 13 months in barrels for Les Gueules Pressées.

For 4 generations, the Coletti family has been running their estate in the historic Prosecco region, some 50 km north of Venice. However, it is only in recent years, under the impetus of Massimo, a fervent supporter of organic farming and trained as an oenologist, that the grapes are no longer delivered to the cooperatives, but are used to make the estate's own wines. The latter aim to recover the traditional Prosecco, as it was done before the internationalization of the wines, and the markets quickly recognized the quality work accomplished. This is a far cry from the "industrial" Prosecco with its coarse aromas and residual sugars that line the shelves of supermarkets. Very light bubbles and aromatic finesse distinguish the Prosecco Frizzante Phoja (ideal aperitif), while Via Larghe 01, Grigio or L'Innominato are close to a "pet nat", natural sparkling wine, with pre-fermentation, without disgorging or filtration.

Available in numerous vintages, their wines are not lacking in power, but the energy they give off does not hide a satiny texture and a lot of brilliance. They do not copy Burgundy in any way, but share with it an ideal of finesse in the expression of the terroir. Astonishing rosé and white wines.

Return in our portfolio of this pioneer of German natural wine, Rudolf Trossen, who has been managing his vineyards (some of them very old: no grafted vines) planted on the steep slopes of the Moselle valley in bio-dynamic way since 1976! All the vintages of the Purus range are vinified without the addition of sulfites and differ only in the nature of the soil, the exposure of the plots, their acidity, residual sugar and alcoholic degree, the balance being always miraculous. Exceptionally, in 2019, the Madonna cuvée, whose grapes were 100% Oechsle, did not transform all its sugars into alcohol and constitutes a superb dessert wine, the Riesling giving it the indispensable freshness. Purity and depth characterize these wines, which are suitable for harmonious aging.

Like Jason Graeb, for example, she favors respect for nature and puts herself at the service, year after year, of the harvest that her work and especially the weather offer her. She has a real talent for reading and interpreting the particularities of the vintage, magnifying it while preserving it.

Lesehof STAGARD, Stein an der Donau

This estate was already cultivated several centuries ago by Benedictine monks. In 1786, it was acquired by the family of the current owners - which means that 6 generations have succeeded each other in some 230 years. In 2006, the 12 hectares were converted to organic farming. Hand-picking and slow vinification are the rule. The estate, characterized by the variety of exposures and subsoils, as well as the tempering influence of the Danube on the climate, is mainly planted with Riesling (numerous single-vineyard cuvées expressing the miraculous combination of the liveliness of the grape variety, fruit and, for a few of them, a very fine sweetness) and Grüner Veltliner (the emblematic grape variety of Austria, giving wines that are always dry, generally fruity, with spicy and peppery notes, not devoid of minerality).

DOMAINE DE KALATHAS, Tinos

On granite terraces swept by meltem and vines that have not been affected by phylloxera, Jérôme Binda produces surprising wines at the Domaine de Kalathas in the beautiful Cyclade Tinos. Our winegrower works hard and since 2011, he has been perfectly integrated into the island's inhabitants, whose daily concerns he shares. The vines are of a certain age, difficult to specify, as is the identity of some of the native grape varieties. The wines are made in an eminently artisanal manner and any chemistry is naturally prohibited (no added sulphites). With a strong salinity and discreet acidity as a common thread, but which reveals itself over time, the three selected cuvées offer (even more so after decanting) an aromatic palette of great delicacy, complexity and length in the mouth. And so as not to spoil anything, these precious bottles are beautifully dressed.

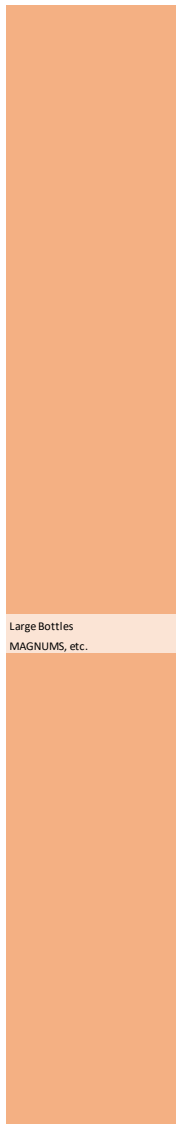
